How should I structure my dissertation in order to make the most out of my argument? Should I write a monograph or an article based dissertation? In which order should the arguments be presented? Should I discuss theory, method and empirical findings underway in the text, or is it best to do so in separate chapters?

Everybody who has written larger projects knows that new dilemmas emerge all the time. For example: If I follow up on this argument right here, then a different argument will be lost. How can I prioritize? Are there good ways of solving these problems?

We invite all PhD candidates to present a problem related to their own project design: whether large or small, whether you are early in your writing process or almost done. Kari Jegerstedt will give a short introduction. After that we will have a shared brainstorm before we work on the specific problems in groups.
