Extensive work is underway with content production and technical development of the website. Launch autumn 2026.

What is the Women's Health Portal?

This is a website that will be a national digital web portal with safe, research-based and ad-free information about women's health in a life course perspective. The portal is being developed with funding from the government and the Ministry of Health and Care Services. The purpose of the website is to make important research more accessible to the general public, health professionals, researchers and decision-makers, and to contribute to better health services and increased knowledge about gender differences in health. The portal will:

- Provide the public with safe and research-based knowledge.
- Be a supplement to clinical practice.
- Contribute to the dissemination of existing knowledge in health education, which in turn can change and improve clinical practice.
- Raise awareness among decision-makers about women's health and research in the field.
- Put current issues on the national agenda and drive the field forward.

Collaboration with research communities

There are large gaps when it comes to research-based knowledge on women's health. Research that does exist, needs to have a broader outreach, to the population at large, the health services and the health professions education. Through collaboration, the portal will:

- promote and disseminate existing and new research, as well as present the latest news from research communities throughout Norway. This will be done through thematic pages with research-based content, news stories about new research, podcasts, interviews with doctoral candidates about what they are researching etc.
- map all research communities that conduct research on women's health in Norway, to contribute to increased collaboration between them.
- inform about research funding one can apply for.
- inform about research projects that want participants for studies, so that they can get in touch with users and patients who want to participate.

The Women's Health Portal Norway will provide researchers with opportunities to broaden the reach of their work!
